How to Get Started

Four Steps

Step ONE: Select a person(s) [Recommend 3 persons & write names on Harvest Board]

* From the pools of ACQUAINTANCES, FRIENDS, SCHOOL, WORK, NEIGHBORHOOD, RELATIVES, RECREATION ETC.

*Pray that God will provide opportunities to make relational contact, and that God will remove any obstacles in making those initial contacts.

* Pray for wisdom in developing a strategic relationship.

Step TWO: Develop a "Strategic Relationship."

- * Gather information and make observations about their needs, religious exposure, hobbies, schedule, interests, etc. for the purposes of relationship building.
- * Plan contact and relationship opportunities. i.e. invite for dinner, common interest activities, provide needs, etc.
- * Become a real loving and caring friend.

Step THREE: Communicate the Gospel.

- * Take them to the Gospel (a gospel presentation. i.e.. Church preaching, crusade, Christmas/ Easter Musical & Gospel program, coffee house, Gospel concerts, outreach activity. etc.)
- * Take the Gospel to them. (You personally sharing the Gospel with them via your own testimony and Biblical presentation)

Step FOUR: Follow-up, Disciple, Equip for Service.

* Personal one on one, corporate Bible studies, small group study, modeling/mentoring relationships in a local church.
